1. AUTHORITY.

The event will be conducted under the International Sporting Code of FIA, the National Competition Rules of the CAMS, Khanacross Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any further regulations or instructions which may be issued, and will be subject to CAMS Permit No:- 712/0502/02. The event will be conducted under and in accordance with the CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found at www.cams.com.au

2. PROMOTER.

5. EVENT DESCRIPTION. – SEE BULLETIN

6. START

Competition will start at 10.30am and will finish at approximately 5.00pm.

7. ENTRIES

Entries will open on 1st January 2012 and will be received on the day up to 9.30am.

The entry fee is \$20.00.

Entry forms must be completed in full, accompanied by the entry fee and lodged with the secretary of the event.

Cheques and money orders should be made payable to: North West Car Club Inc.

Entries accompanied by a cheque are not contractual until the cheque is honoured.

The event will be limited to 50 starters.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason therefore: NCR 83.

The Organisers accept no responsibility for an entry lost or delayed in the mail.

8. PERSONS ELIGIBLE.

The event shall be open to members of the North West Car Club, Drivers must hold a current and valid CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ or higher licence. No driver shall be under the age of 12. Drivers 12 and 13 years of age must be accompanied by an experienced instructor, as approved by the Clerk of the Course. It is recommended that 12- and 13-year-old drivers participate in a Junior Development Program or CAMS Ignition Program before competing in Khanacross events.

No driver shall enter a khanacross in more than one car.

A \$5 event membership available to members of other CAMS affiliated clubs. (Current Membership cards need to be presented)

9. PARENTAL CONSENT.

The signed parental consent of the Parent or Guardian of any competitor under the age of 18 years must appear on the entry form.

10. DOCUMENTATION and SCRUTINY

Documentation and Scrutiny will take place in the designated Scrutiny Area between 9.00am and 10.00am. Competitors are required to sign in and produce the following documentation to the event secretary by 9:30am **and prior to scrutiny.**

Current Club Membership Cards

Current Level 2NS (or superior) CAMS Licence

Competitors are then required to present their vehicles for scrutiny in a ready to race condition with helmets.

Vehicles presented after 930am will not be accepted.

It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure their CAMS license details are current and correct prior to documentation if not contact CAMS MEMBER SERVICES 1300 653 529

SINGLE EVENT LICENCES ARE ONLY AVAILABLE VIA PRE-ARRANGEMENT

A driver whose vehicle has broken down may use a replacement vehicle, provided that the consent of the Clerk of Course has first been obtained. The replacement vehicle must be scrutineered, should preferably be of the same class as the original vehicle and must then be used for the remainder of the day's competition.

11. BRIEFING.

All drivers must attend briefing that will be held at the venue at 10.15am. If necessary a further briefing will be held prior to individual tests.

12. INSURANCE.

Public Risk Insurance has been affected by the promoter. All drivers and officials are covered by the Motor Sport Personal Accident Policy. For further details see Appendix I of the Manual of Motor Sport.

13. TIMING

Timing will be by means of Electronic Stopwatch. The timekeeper is deemed Judge of Fact.

14. PROTESTS

Any protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.

15. ABANDONMENT

The event may be altered, postponed or abandoned in accordance with NCR 59.

16. ANTI DOPING POLICY

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

Other Prohibited Substances

The CAMS Anti Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti Doping Policy will take precedence

17. CLASSES

The event will be divided up into the following classes;

Juniors

Ladies

A. 0 - 1600cc

B. 1601cc - 2000cc

C. Over 2000cc

D. 4H Vehicles (Motorkhana Specials)

E. 4-Wheel Drive Production Cars

In the case of dispute, the Clerk of Course shall determine the appropriate class in which a competitor shall be classified.

18. AWARDS

There will be various Awards for Juniors and Ladies along with club competition points.

19. SAFETY-DRIVERS

- For open vehicles and specials, neck to wrist to ankle clothing must be worn.
- All drivers must wear suitable and appropriate footwear whilst competing. NCR 141(vii).
- All drivers shall wear a safety helmet complying with a standard listed in Schedule D of the NCR (refer to Section 6 of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport).
- Goggles or a helmet with visor (to AS 1609-1981) must be worn in all open cars and in closed cars which have the windscreen removed.
- At least a three-point seat belt, properly adjusted, must be worn while competing.

VEHICLES

- All vehicles must comply with CAMS Group 4H and Schedule A of the NCR (refer “General Requirements for Cars and Drivers” in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport). All Group 4H vehicles must comply with Motorkhana Cars – Group 4H vehicle requirements (refer “Auto Test” in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport). All vehicles defined as a special by Group 4H must be fitted with a roll over protection structure complying with Schedule J (refer “General Requirements for Cars and Drivers”). Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.
- All competing vehicles shall be scrutineered for safety and eligibility before the start of the event, including any convoy run. Particular attention will be paid to brakes, steering and tyres.
- The Clerk of the Course shall rule on the acceptability of any vehicle to compete in the event and on the class in which it shall compete. Acceptable standards of presentation and condition must be met.
- A driver whose vehicle has broken down may use a replacement vehicle, provided the consent of the Clerk of the Course has first been obtained. The replacement vehicle must be scrutineered, should preferably be in the same class as the original vehicle, and must be used for the remainder of the competition.
- A fire extinguisher of at least 900g capacity, complying with Schedule H of the NCR (refer General Requirements for Cars and Drivers) must be fitted.

20. REMINDERS

It is the competitor’s responsibility to ensure they have read and understood these supplementary regulations and entry form.
